EV Adoption S-Curves Will Vary By Area

- Fast adoption (climate policy): Norway...but overall oil demand still flat-to-up slightly
- Fast adoption (geopolitics): China...but oil demand still growing at healthy clip
- Major growing pains (economics): US...but hybrids picking up some of the slack
